SCRIPTURES OF CHOICE

ASV: AMERICAN STANDARD VERSION 1901 a variant of the English Revised Version published in 1881-1885. By the middle of the nineteenth century, the development of Biblical

studies and discovery of many manuscripts more ancient than those upon which the King James Version was based, made it manifest to call for revision of the English translation. The task was undertaken, by authority of the Church of England, in 1870. Its variant embodying the preferences of American scholars associated with the work, was published in 1901.

KJV: KING JAMES VERSION The first English version of the Scriptures made by direct

translation from the original Hebrew and Greek, and the first to be printed was the work of William Tyndale. He was betrayed into the hands of his enemies, and in October 1536, was publicly executed and burned at the stake. The King James Version became the "Authorized Version of 1611" of the English speaking peoples. To the most high and mighty Prince JAMES, By the grace of God, King of

Great Britain, France and Ireland, Defender of the Faith, The translators of the Bible wish Grace, Mercy, and Peace through JESUS CHRIST our Lord.

LXX: SEPTUAGINT The Bible Jesus and the Apostles used; was translated at Alexanderia, Egypt; by seventy Jewish scholars sent from Jerusalem, by the high priest, at the request of Ptolemy Philadelphus (285-247 B.C.). There can be no question about the scholarship of these Jewish scribes and their knowledge of the

Hebrew language. They frequently give (in their Greek version) a free translation of the Hebrew text before them, the question of a paraphrase does not arise here. They translated one Hebrew word by one Greek word. They simply translated the text that was before them, nearly three centuries before the birth of Christ. Jews and Christians in the first century had great reverence for the Septaugint. Philo held this translation was divinely inspired. The learned Hebrew scribes who wrote the Babylonian

Talmud also ascribed divine inspiration to the translators. When Christians began to proclaim the gospel it became evident how clearly the Septuagint substantiated Christian doctrines causing the Jews to reverse themselves completely turning in furious hatred against the Septuagint, proceeding to burn and destroy all the copies they could.
