Matthew 1: 1 ASV The word "generation" occurs 14 times in many translations of the Bible. The last time is in Matthew 1: 1. It establishes the birthline of Jesus in history. Ten times Matthew identifies Jesus as the Son of David. Spoken of as the Son of Abraham relates Him to the seed and the land. He is an Israeli. The genealogy is here for anyone to examine and debate. It is absolutely

necessary for the cause. If you find an error here, you need not believe His claim as Only Savior. The Anointed One must be supported by the accuracy of His birth record. The family line is given; 7 (In the roll of the book it is written of me), O God. Hebrews 10: 7 ASV God registered His Son's birth in the family Bible.

 Jesus Christ's character and ministry is in every book of the Bible. He is just as much the Christ of the Old Testament as in the New Testament. The birth record given by Matthew relates to Joseph the supposed father; 23 Jesus, when he began to teach, was about thirty years of age, being the son (as was supposed) of Joseph, the son of Heli. Luke 3: 23 ASV It connects Jesus with the covenants of Abraham and David, shows His legal right to the throne of David.

- We have two records; one by Matthew and the other by Luke. The lineage is different from any other ever recorded. The character and ministry is authenticated in the books by Jesus Christ and Him alone.
- The record given by Luke relates Jesus to humanity and the covenant with Adam. It shows Christ's legal right to the throne of David, by tracing family of the House of David. Both Mary and Joseph were of the House of David.

 How can Matthew indicate Joseph's father to be Jacob and Luke indicate Joseph's father to be Heli?

Mary, the mother of Jesus, was of the same tribe and family as Joseph. 1 And there shall come forth a shoot out of the stock of Jesse, and a branch out of his roots shall bear fruit.

Isaiah 11:1 ASV This verse implies Messiah was the seed of David by natural as well as legal descent. Jacob and Eli were brothers; Jacob

(Matthew's genealogy) fathered one child, a daughter Mary. Eli (Luke's genealogy) fathered Joseph. Joseph and Mary were first cousins. Levitical Law required Joseph to wed Mary. 8 And every daughter, that possesseth an inheritance in any tribe of the children of Israel, shall be wife unto one of the family of the tribe of her father, that the children of Israel may possess every man the inheritance of his fathers. 9 So shall no inheritance remove from one tribe to another tribe; for the tribes of the

- children of Israel shall cleave every one to his own inheritance. Numbers 36:8-9 ASV
- Jesus united in His person the only two claims to the throne of Israel. While He lives there can be no other claimant. Royal blood coursed through His veins. What does that mean today?
- Jesus Christ is more than a peasant of Galilee,
 His claims prove that:
 - 25 The woman saith unto him, I know that Messiah cometh (he that is called Christ): when he is come, he will declare unto us all things.

26 Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he. John 4: 25-26 ASV

I am the living bread which came down out of heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: yea and the bread which I will give is my flesh, for the life of the world. John 6: 51 ASV

He changed our calendar from B.C. to A.D. Didn't He? Believe then; He can change souls from goats to sheep. First, He came to die. His death takes the hell out of man's soul. Second, He has made the promise to take hell out of man's circumstances; 28 ye who have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit on the throne of his glory, shall be
