Wednesday 21 June, 2017 A.D. (Anno Domini – In the year of our Lord) Wednesday 27 Sivan, 5777

- All of us know that we should be praying. Yet prayer is not practiced with any regularity, fervency, or quantity.
- Why are we not praying like we should?
- Cynicism undergirds our resistance to this divinely ordained practice. We think to ourselves, God does not actually answer prayers. Why should I bother? Everything will turn out the same anyway.
- This is the reason Wednesday night Prayer and Bible Study meetings are barren.

- If we thought God answered prayers, Bible Study would be full, as long as food is on the table and everything is in order, we are confident that we have everything handled. We are not desperate enough to pray!
- Health concerns are the primary topic of prayer. Such prayer is not bad, but significant issues are usually absent.
- Are we praying for the renewal of our minds, the transformation of our deceitful hearts, are we praying for repentance and revival?

• Text: Matthew 9: 22 KJV

Thy faith hath made thee whole.

• Text: Matthew 9: 29 KJV

According to your faith be it done unto you.

- Faith made the believer whole in Bible days, and faith can make us whole today.
- Text: Romans 10: 17 KJV

Faith comes by hearing the Word of God.

Text: Matthew 17: 20 KJV

If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, said Jesus, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place, and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

- "Well, if the Lord heals me, I'll believe and be converted," we hear someone say.
- Jesus didn't heal under those conditions when He was on earth. Healing was not received first and faith afterward.

- One can not bargain with the Lord exchanging service for healing. Many forget their vows and promises to God after the answer has come.
- According to your own faith, it wll be done to you.
- Do not fix your eyes upon your own condition or surroundings.

- By faith today, you can be made whole!
- You ask how?
- Be Born Again.
- Make an out and out Surrender to Jesus Christ.
- Do Not Come On Your Own Merits.
- Have Active Faith in God.
- Step Out Boldly upon the Promise.

- Our focus on salvation and healing has been a first for some. Few fellowships practice or teach this doctrine.
- For lack of understanding, they can not receive blessing.
- This is where we begin in earnest tonight.

- As it is written, has Jehovah given us a spirit of slumber, that our eyes should not see and ears that should not hear? (Romans 11: 8 ASV)
- So many brethren and sisters today can not receive blessing because according to your faith be it done unto you.
- If you don't ask you can't receive.
- Have faith like a little child, ask the Father.
- **Text:** Luke 11: 9-13 ASV

And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your

heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?
