- We have today what we tolerated yesterday and we'll have tomorrow what we tolerate today!
- When President Obama announced that the United States of "America is no longer a Christian nation" he stated he was going to "fundamentally transform America."
- We're aware of government attacks on Chick'
   Fil A, Hobby Lobby and Little Sisters of the poor over gay rights and birth control. The IRS set

out to destroy and discredit the Billy Graham organization through audits that revealed no wrong doing. Same sex marriage, gender neutral bathrooms are part of the past President's legacy.

- Human government is instituted from God.
- Those in authority are described as servants of God.
- Those in power hold their power because God allows it.

- God knew we would require governing rules and laws to protect and maintain order in civilization.
- Text: Romans 13: 1-3 ASV

Let every soul be in subjection to the higher powers: for there is no power but of God; and the powers that be are ordained of God. Therefore he that resisteth the power, withstandeth the ordinance of God: and they that withstand shall receive to themselves judgment. For rulers are not a terror to the

good work, but to the evil. And wouldest thou have no fear of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise from the same.

and practice what it teaches us to do in obedience to God.
