• The scheme of this verse is faith and trust. The

first objection is "You cannot call on God unless you believe in Him. You cannot believe in Him unless you hear about Him. You cannot hear about Him unless there is someone to proclaim the good news. There can be no one to proclaim the good news unless God commissions or dispatches someone to do so." Paul tells the Jews you cannot say there was no messenger; Isaiah describes these very messengers; and Isaiah lived a long time ago. How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet

of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth! Thy watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the Lord shall bring again Zion. Isaiah 52: 7-8 KJV Then Paul tells the Jews they did not accept and obey the good news from God, they were running true to form; history was repeating itself. Who hath believed

our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed? Isaiah 53: 1 KJV

- Paul sets two things side by side; first everything is of God, and second, everything is of human choice. It is a dilemma of human experience and there is no resolution to it. We know that God is behind everything; and yet, at the same time, we know that we have free will, and that we can accept or reject the offer of God.
- Bringing good news I want everyone to drink it

in. Yet, we all know that you can lead a horse to water, but you cannot make him drink.
