Jesus answered, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I bear with you?

Jesus said, all things are possible to him that believeth.

- If you dwell on things that are negative,
- If you fail to fight the battle in your mind,
- If you speak words of discouragement, doubt and fear,
- You block the blessing of Jehovah.

- What is the difference?
- Good or bad seed.
- Text: II Corinthians 10: 3-5 ASV

We walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but mighty before God to the casting down of strongholds, casting down imaginations, and every high thing that is

exalted against the knowledge of God, and bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

- Bad seed, our negative ideas, thoughts and concepts become reality limiting or negating our blessing from Jehovah.
- You must replace bad seed with good seed!
- Think about having put trust in someone or something and finding disappointment.

 The apostle Paul wrote, I am not ashamed; for I know him whom I have believed, and I am persuaded that he is able to guard that which I have committed unto him against that day.

II Timothy 1: 12 ASV

- Being persuaded is being in a place beyond doubt. Believe the Word of God!
- For how many soever be the promises of God, in Him is the yea: wherefore also through Him is the Amen, unto the glory of God through us.

II Corinthians 1: 20 ASV

• Text: Proverbs 3: 5-6 ASV

Trust in Jehovah with all thy heart, And lean not upon thine own understanding: In all thy ways acknowledge him, And he will direct thy paths.

• Text: Matthew 6: 25-34 ASV

Be not anxious for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than the food, and the body than the raiment? Behold the birds of the heaven, that they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns;

and your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are not ye of much more value then they? And which of you by being anxious can add one cubit unto the measure of his life? And why are ye anxious concerning raiment? - Let our voices unite in an intimate prayer.
- I come boldly to the throne of grace, that I may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4: 16
- Elohim of my fathers, and Adhonai of mercy, who has made all things with Your Word, Wisdom 9: 1

- and ordained man through Your wisdom, that he should have dominion over all creatures which You have made, Wisdom 9: 2
- and ordered the world according to equity and righteousness, and execute judgment with an upright heart: Wisdom 9: 3
- give me wisdom, that sits by Your throne; and reject me not from among Your children;

Wisdom 9: 4

 send her out of Your holy heavens, and from the throne of Your glory, that being present she

- may labor with me, that I may know what is pleasing unto You. Wisdom 9: 10
- For she knows and understands all things, and she shall lead me soberly in my doings, and preserve me in her power. Wisdom 9: 11
- So all my works shall be acceptable. Wisdom 9: 12
- Asking all in Jesus name. John 14: 14
- Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as in heaven. Matthew 6: 10
