 Today many think the Old Testament has no practical application to our lives, we live under the New Testament Covenant. Take a closer look at this example of a Father disciplining his children. Father set order in the family to keep his children out of trouble. His commands had been published and his servants and teachers not only knew the commands but honored them. His children rejected the statutes, doing evil and provoking the father to anger. The father sat his disobedient children down, explained they were just like their older brothers

who failed to obey. The loving father put the children in Time Out, removing them from his sight, and they didn't like it.

- Text: II Kings 17: 13-18 ASV
- Jehovah testified unto Israel, and unto Judah, by every prophet, and every seer, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep my commandments and my statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets. Notwithstanding, they would not hear,

but hardened their neck, like to the neck of their fathers, who believed not in Jehovah their God. And they rejected his statutes, and his covenant that he made with their fathers, and his testimonies which he testified unto them; and they followed vanity, and became vain, and went after the nations that were round about them, concerning whom Jehovah had charged them that they should not do like them. And they forsook all the commandments of Jehovah their God, and made them molten images, even two calves, and made an Asherah (goddess),

and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal. And they caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do that which was evil in the sight of Jehovah, to provoke him to anger. Therefore Jehovah was very angry with Israel, and removed them out of his sight.

 The loving father's rules are still published. His servant the Holy Spirit, not only knows the commands but honors them, teaching the children, gospel about their brother who was

obedient unto death.

- The Holy Spirit acting upon a child is not always understood, until the child recognizes Divine Destiny and becomes obedient. Physical, mental or spiritual manifestations can arise causing difficulty in their life, until they receive blessing. Such experiences come into sharp focus in ministry.
- Today we are the Father's servants and prophets.

- Servants, prophets, apostles who came before us are example.
- Saints like king David are example.
- Our brother Jesus is example.
- The Holy Spirit is example.
- We have example of our Father rejecting the seed of Jacob, afflicting them and delivering them into the hand of spoilers until they had been cast out of His sight (II Kings 17: 20 ASV).

- We have the example of Israel being rent from the house of David because his legacy drove them from following the LORD (II Kings 17: 21 ASV).
- Are we so stiffnecked to think we will not be held accountable for causing or allowing sons and daughters to pass through what is evil in the sight of our Lord?
- When we use our liberty to worship other gods by choosing adiction, abortion, or our financial peace are we so stiffnecked to forget Joseph,

Daniel and Ezekiel who were carried away out of their own lands?

- The very same spoilers used to rent the house of David remain with us today. Chaldeans are alive and thriving in Iran. Assyrians are alive and thriving in Turkey. Meades and Persians are alive and thriving in Iraq.
- Text: II Kings 17: 35-40 ASV

Jehovah made a covenant, saying, Ye shall not fear other gods, nor bow yourselves to them, nor serve them, nor sacrifice to them: but

Jehovah, who brought us out of the land of Egypt with great power and an outstretched arm, Him shall ye fear, and unto Him shall ye bow yourselves, and to Him shall ye sacrifice: and the statutes and the ordinances, and the law and the commandment, which He wrote for you, ye shall observe to do for evermore; and ye shall not fear other gods: and the covenant that I have made with you ye shall not forget; neither shall ye fear other gods: but Jehovah your God shall ye fear; and He will deliver you out of the hand of all your enemies. Howbeit

- you did not hearken, after their former manner?
- Hezekiah king of Judah, received a letter from the Assyrian king, Sennacherib declaring intent to besiege Jerusalem causing the children of God, our brothers, 27 to eat their own dung, and to drink their own piss. II Kings 18: 27 KJV After reading the letter, Hezekiah went up into the house of the LORD, and spread it before the LORD.

Of a truth, Jehovah, the kings of Assyria have laid waste the nations and their lands, and have cast their gods into the fire; for they were no gods, but the work of

men's hands, wood and stone; therefore they have destroyed them. Now therefore, O Jehovah our God, save thou us, I beseech thee, out of his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that thou Jehovah art God alone.

 Jehovah, heard this prayer and Isaiah the prophet, son of Amoz was sent to Hezekiah, saying, this is the word Jehovah has spoken. Our loving Father answered Hezekiah through his servant, Isaiah, blessing Israel and us today.
