- The Holy Spirit acting upon a believer is not always understood, until the believer recognizes their divine destiny and becomes obedient. Physical, mental or spiritual manifestations can arise causing difficulty in their life, until they receive blessing. Such experiences come into sharp focus in ministry. Life experiences inspired this message.
- Conferring holy order is to ordain. Whom He foreordained, them He also called: and whom He called, He also justified: and whom He

justified, them He also glorified (Romans 8: 30). Our Creator's plan, our written destiny, is foreordained or predestined orders, recorded for us before being birthed into the earth. God grants freedom of choice. Everything in the spirit realm has liberty to choose to live following divine destiny or purpose their own. It is the individuals responsibility to qualify and know things important to our Creator and His will.

 Today as an ambassador that boldly makes known the mystery of the gospel, I write exhorting you, as husband and minister. In the ordained manner, after marriage, my bride and I were blessed with two sons. We welcomed each into this world earlier than expected; the first at 7 months and the second at 6 months. Our stewardship began when they were born of this world and we held high hopes and expectations for them. We have loved and sacrificed for them thirty-seven years. Today our hopes are just as lofty, though they are

mingled with pride for accomplishments they have made. We have been blessed and share our common faith, eternally.

• Text: I Corinthians 7: 20-24 ASV

Let each man abide in that calling wherein he was called. Wast thou called being a bondservant? Care not for it: nay, even if thou canst become free, use it rather. For he that was called in the Lord being a bondservant, is the Lord's freedman: likewise he that was called being free, is Christ's bondservant. Ye were

bought with a price; become not bondservants of men. Brethren, let each man, wherein he was called, therein abide with God.

- Individuals given a glimpse of divine destiny, by knowledge, wisdom, or revelation, discover their calling. Knowing your divine purpose, is to be called. You know you are called, when you delight in your holy orders and proclaim them to everyone.
- Many don't have a clue about divine destiny or calling. They don't know or understand their

body is a temple of the Holy Spirit which is in you, which you have from God? and they are not their own; they were bought with a price and should glorify God (I Corinthians 6: 19-20). Nor do they know or understand fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with men, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God (I Corinthians 6: 9-10).

 In the roll of the book it is written of me: I delight to do thy will, O my God; Yea, thy law is within my heart. I have proclaimed glad tidings of righteousness in the great assembly; Lo, I will not refrain my lips, O Jehovah, thou knowest (Psalm 40: 7-9 ). Protocol for being conformed to the image of his Son, who was made flesh, and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth (John 1: 14), is thou shall confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in thine heart that God has raised Him from the dead. Thou shall be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto

righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation (Romans 10: 9-10). Forgiven you are justified. You are rendered innocent of all accusations. Every accusation against you by satan has been silenced! The justified are glorified. Glorified means choosing to live divine destiny, ordained by our Creator, sent out of heaven and birthed into the earth. What can we ever say to such wonderful things as these? If God is on our side, who can ever be against us (Romans 8: 31)?

- I pray, God may count you worthy of your calling, and fulfil every desire of goodness and every work of faith, with power; that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
