#### Succoring

- Gifted three heirloom tomato plants this year, they were planted in our back yard. They were nurtured by watering and Miracle Grow. They grew tall and strong with lots of vine. As blossoms began to sprout they were so numerous the vine could not support the fruit. Pinching off blossoms and branches, helped the plant, leaving a strong vine to support the fruit for harvest. Succoring allows the fruit to fully develop producing a better harvest.
- Text: John 15: 1-8 ASV

I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. Every branch in me that beareth not fruit, he taketh it away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he cleanseth it, that it may bear more fruit. Already ye are clean because of the word which I have spoken unto you. Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; so neither can ye, except ye abide in me. I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same beareth much fruit:

for apart from me ye can do nothing. If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and they gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatsoever ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; and so shall ye be my disciples.

   Now the sons of Eli were base men; they knew not Jehovah.
- Who is Belial? Belial standing in contrast to Christ must denote all antichristian pollutions personified, as Satan is opposed to Christ.

- Actions of the Holy Spirit are not always understood, until the believer recognizes divine destiny and becomes obedient. Physical, mental or spiritual manifestations can arise causing difficulty in life, until they receive blessing. Such experiences come into sharp focus in ministry. Life experiences inspired this message.
- A popular belief in our culture today, the Prosperity Gospel, is good news! Yet, I caution

those who follow and believe not to quench the Holy Spirit. God the Judge of all, and Jesus the mediator of a new covenant (Hebrews 12: 23-24 ASV), will comfort and console us when we fail. He will also chasten and press us to greater holiness. His grace doesn't just forgive us; His grace empowers us to overcome sin. God, as the Judge of all, wants to fulfill the dreams, desires, and longings for His family, just as earthly fathers do. God will never compromise Himself as Judge in order to fulfill His fatherly

desires. To do so would make Him less than God.

- Planned parenthood sounds innocent enough. More than 50 million of God's creatures have had their blood spilled, because no one wanted them. What does blood testimony from more than 50 million sound like crying out against the United States of America in the court of Heaven?
- Marrying someone you love seems innocent

enough. What does the testimony of 20 million sodomites (10% of a 200 million population) sound like crying out against the United States of America in the court of Heaven? What did the outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah sound like when it reached the throne of God?

 Making certain of whom you choose to marry seems innocent enough. Women become the Asherah (a fertility goddess), when they live with men. What does testimony from 20 million

Baby Mommas sound like crying out against the United States of America in the court of Heaven?

 Living within your means sounds innocent enough. Stewardship is biblical. Remember, the steward doesn't own the portfolio. It is the Master, who owns the thousand cattle on the hills. Do you hear people planning for their retirement? Do you ever hear anyone say they are using their talents investing for the kingdom

of God? What does testimony of the wizards of financal planning preaching Financial Peace and the worshippers of the DOW and NYSE sound like crying out against the United States of America in the court of Heaven?

 Text: II Corinthians 6: 14-18 ASV
 Be not unequally yoked with unbelievers: for what fellowship have righteousness and iniquity? or what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what portion hath a believer with an

unbeliever? And what agreement hath a temple of God with idols? for we are a temple of the living God; even as God said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.
